BACKGROUND: The Board approved a budget of \$50,000 for the purchase of body cameras for NCCSIF's police agencies. The Police Risk Management Committee has met and approved the purchase of body cameras, with VieVu, during its meeting on August 7, 2014. On August 27th, 2014 a VieVu Training Session was provided to member to answer any questions regarding the equipment and software. Program Consultants have since shipped all of the cameras to participating agencies according to the approved allocation.
